Logging In To Sleipnir

Sleipnir is the Linux system which we will be using in the class to create C++ programs. You can access Sleipnir from home (or anywhere outside of campus) using Putty or other SSH software.

If you use Microsoft Windows

You can download Putty or use other SSH software (for example, FireFox FireSSH Addin, Chrome Secure Shell Plugin). See the other Helpful Doc on how to set up and configure Putty.

If you use a Mac

Launch Terminal by going to Applications > Utilities > Terminal. Once in Terminal, type

```
$ ssh your-user-name@sleipnir.cs.csub.edu
```

Then, follow the prompts for your password.

If you use Linux (with a graphical Desktop Environment)

Try pressing Ctrl+Alt+T. This usually opens up the Terminal window. If it doesn't, look for Terminal under the Applications group. Once in Terminal, enter the ssh command as shown in the Mac example above.
